

Original Group Generating Start up Capital for other needy OG member through “PASSING ON”

‘Dipti Rekha Karunalaya’ a SHG having 15 members have joined the Mayurbhanj Socio Economic Development Project (MSED) in March 2015 as Original Groups (OG) of SAKTI SIKHA DEVELOPMENT SOCIETY (SDS) in Koliana block. *Sabita Hansda* with another 14 member of ‘Maa Kamala Bharasha’ SHG and *Singo Hembram* with another 14



member of ‘Maa Bhabani’ SHG have also joined the MSED as Original Group. Through MSED project these SHGs have taken training on 12 Cornerstone, SHG Management, Improved Animal Management, Backyard Poultry Management, Agri Kitchen Garden and Gender & Justice. During the era of about 15 months of implementation, the continuous training and PSRP of MSED project bring a positive change among the OG members of these groups and they become inspiration to other member of the project.

All the families of these groups are belonging to landless or very small land holding families. They are maintaining their livelihood through agriculture, daily wage earner and rearing small livestock like Goat and Poultry. Goat and Poultry are the major sources of livelihood for the families of these groups. Some of the members of these three OG have no goat and poultry. The OG member sitting with the PMC has decided to make ‘Pass On’ to help other OG member of their group and other Group in earning livelihood through goatary and poultry.

The PMC carried on the 3rd ‘Pass On’ ceremony of SDS at the Badtilou villages with SDS staffs. The PMC leads the activities. The passes on made during the ceremony are as follows -
