NRM cum Agriculture Officer:

Job Description:

- # Be the focal point for helping communities develop the NRM component of the Village Development Plans;
- # Assess with the communities the main constraints and opportunities in improving productivity and income from crop, horticulture, forestry and livestock activities;
- # Organize dissemination of improved package of practices on crop, horticulture, livestock and forestry through farmer field schools, demonstrations, field days;
- # Train CSP so that they in turn train producers; make sure that inputs required for improved package of practices can be readily available;
- # Monitor and report on progress of land and water, agriculture, forestry and livestock activities.
