Rest of the amount Rs.13,66,210/- has parked under the head of Unutilized Fund from HEIFER International in the Liability side of the Balance Sheet which will be considered as income for the F.Y.- 2016-17.

In our opinion and to the best of our information, and according to information given to us , the said accounts give a true and fair view-

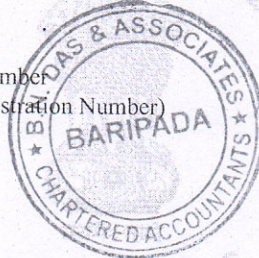
